Congregational Care Ministry Team

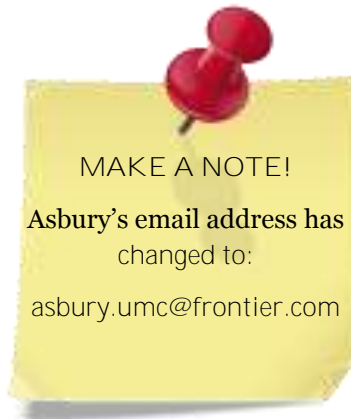

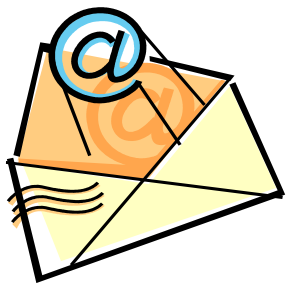
Croasdaile Social
